



A Level/AS Level Results 2020

The tenacity of our students at Rockport was evident during this unprecedented period, where our students performed brilliantly across the board, achieving great results.

The A Level results for 2020 saw A2 students achieving a pass rate of 100% in A Levels (or equivalent) and a top pass rate of 81.8% at Grades A*-C or equivalent. Top grades of A*-A were awarded to 27.3% of students.

AS students achieved 100% pass rate in AS examinations, with 93.3% of AS exams achieving A*-C grades and an outstanding 36.7% of grades being awarded at A*-A grades.

Deputy Head, Mrs Rhonda D. Palmer, said;

"I am so proud of each and every one of our students who received results. During these difficult times they have all impressed me with their maturity and dedication right to the end of their courses.

I am confident that whatever path is for them next, they will travel it with confidence and resilience."

As in previous years our students have secured places at top-ranking universities, some choosing to stay locally to study Accountancy at Russell Group, Queens University Belfast, and Screen Production at Ulster University. Further afield sees our students heading to study Law at Manchester and Business at Harper Adams.
