# **General News**

## **GCSE and A Level Mock Exams**

All students from Year 11 to Year 14 will be involved in Mock Examinations during this incoming week. These start on Monday morning (7<sup>th</sup> December) at 9.00am and run through until Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December. Students have been fully briefed about what to expect and how to approach the exams, but a few salient points for parents:

Please ensure that students are in school at least 15 minutes before the start time of each exam (morning exams start at 9.00am and afternoon exams start at 1.40pm).

If a student is unable to attend school or is running late, please call the school office to make us aware of the fact.

Students in these year groups may come into school only for exams. Students are reminded that they must sign in and out of school at the school office each day. Students who have morning and afternoon exams are expected to remain in school for a mid-morning revision session, which will be supervised by their teachers. Students are not permitted to leave the campus to have lunch elsewhere and then return for an afternoon examination.

Students are reminded that full school uniform is expected.

Mobile phones and smart watches are not permitted in the examination hall; these should be left at home or left with form teachers in the morning.

Please remember that, if a student is working closely (one-to-one or in an enclosed space with a member of staff), they will be required to wear a face covering.

Students have been provided with a handout detailing all of the necessary information.

Year 11 students will return to timetabled lessons on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> December, Year 13 students on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December, Year 14 Students on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December and Year 12 Students (except French students) return to class on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December.

## **Christmas Lunch and Christmas Jumper Day**

School Christmas lunch day is on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December and all students and staff are invited to wear Christmas Jumpers on that day too! Early Years' children may well have a surprise visitor, if they've been very good!
